

## Bid Corrigendum

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions.

### Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contract rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

## SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of this tender will be generally as per specification schedule of quantities and general / special conditions of contract and as directed by Engineer in charge, on behalf of Corporation. However, the scope of work covered complete in all respect under this contract are as follows:

1. Loading of Uranium ore by mechanical means like wheel Loader from UCIL, Bagjata Mines and transportation of the same up to Mill of UCIL, Jaduguda in covered and well maintained Tippers/Dumper and dumping to the ground hopper of UCIL Mill, Jaduguda including weighment at Jaduguda weigh bridge as per direction of Engineer-in-charge.

2. Loading of Mill Tailing by mechanical means such as wheel loader/JCB Loader from UCIL Jaduguda tailing dock, weighment of tailings to be done at Jaduguda weighbridge and transportation of the same up to UCIL Bagjata Stowing yard in covered and well maintained Tippers/Dumpers, inclusive of all handling, tools etc. complete, as per directions of Engineer-in-charge.

3. Bagjata Mines is located 32 km East of Jaduguda Mines and 11 km East of Mosaboni Mines in the Singhbani East district of Jharkhand State.

5. For quality check of ROM, all Tippers carrying ore have to pass through the BOA (Bulk Ore Analyser)/ARL room before it is being dispatched to Jaduguda.

6. Schedule of work mentioned in BOQ to be carried out as per direction of Engineer-in-charge.

**7. The heavy vehicles required for the work on hire basis should not be manufactured earlier than the year 2019.**

### **8. Spillage etc during transportation of ore and tailing**

While transporting, all loaded dumpers/Hyva etc must be covered with Tarpaulin as per following specification.

(a) Tarpaulin made of canvas/high-density polyethylene cloth stitched and having eyelets fitted on all borders. The size of the tarpaulin shall be larger than the dump box so as to cover the top of the dump box completely.

(b) The tarpaulin is to be fixed on all side hooks of the dumper in such a way that at least it will be 200mm away from the rim of the dump box.

©Tarpaulin must be changed as and when insisted by the Engineer in charge, to avoid the dust and spillage the public surrounding area/villages/on road.

#### 9. Dumping of ore and tailing outside company area

If dumping of ore or tailing becomes unavoidable due to repair and maintenance or any other reasons like turning or any other accidental causes the tenderer shall clear the dumped ore or tailing within 48 hours of the incident and failing to do so, the UCIL shall take steps to clear the ore or tailing and the cost incurred shall be deducted from the running bill of the tenderer. The cost involved to clear the ore or tailing shall be intimated to the tenderer within 48 hours before carrying out the work and if tenderer does not reply immediately after receiving the intimation it will be deemed that tenderer has no objection to the estimated cost.

**Note:-Contractors are advised to see the area get acquainted with the actual features of the site where work is to be executed and get other related information before quoting their rates for carrying out the work successfully.**

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## **Pre-Qualification Criteria**

1. The Bidder must have experience in similar nature of works in last seven years ending on 31/03/2024 by Central/ State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company ending last day of month previous to the date in which applications are invited should be either of the following:

a). One similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to Rs-32.62 Lakh

**or**

b). Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to Rs-20.39 Lakh

**or**

c). Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to Rs-16.31 Lakh

**Similar works** means “**Experience in execution of “Transportation work of Minerals/Tailings/Sand Aggregates/Fly Ash/Other Minerals”**”

2. Minimum average turnover 30 % of the estimated value of the work for last 3(three) financial years and submission of duly audited copy of Profit & loss account and balance sheet of financial years 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23 by Chartered Accountant.

3. Date of award of all the work order must be within 7(seven) years ending on 31/03/2024.

**Note: - Bidders must attach Work done certificate mentioning executed amount and date of completion.**

4. The Bidder shall furnish a copy of MSME/NSIC, ESIC, PAN, GST and PF Registration Number, ITR of the last three financial years.

### **5. Relaxation of conditions for prior turnover and prior experience:**

**Pre-qualification criteria with respect to Prior Turnover and Prior experience may relax for all MSMEs and Start-ups [Whether Micro & Small Enterprises or Otherwise]** as per GOI guidelines subject to meeting of Quality and Technical specifications. UCIL may consider allowing the participation of “Start up” companies with capability to execute the supply/ services, as per technical specifications/ perform the job as per scope of work specified in the tender and subject to meeting extant & relevant guidelines of Government of India. This should be confirmed and substantiated in the technical bid.

The bidder who intends to participate as “Start-up” company should enclose the Certificate of Recognition issued by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion, Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Govt. of India during submission of Technical bid. (AS DEFINED IN GAZETTE NOTIFICATION NO. D.L-33004/99 DATED 18.02.2016 & 3.05.2017 OF MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY), AS AMENDMENT TIME TO TIME).

### **6. Geographic Presence:**

Registered Office or at least one of the registered Branch Office of the bidder shall be located and registered within the geographical limits of East Singhbhum District of Jharkhand State where the services need to be provided. Documentary evidence must be provided in the form of Municipality trade license or other such documents as per the following which satisfies as a proof of having the office establishment. Any document issued by Govt. of India or Govt. Authority of Jharkhand shall be considered for address proof like UDYAM, GSTIN, Trade license issued by Govt. Authority of Jharkhand etc.

Note:-Mere submission of **Rent Agreement** shall not be considered for Office Address proof.
